### MUSIC ADVENTURES (18 months- 6 years)

The Music Adventures is an innovative program that encourages creative expression through music, dance, and related arts such as storytelling, and acting. It is an Orff Schulwerk based program with rhythmic training, ear training, music literacy, and creative movement as the core of the curriculum. The curriculum is sequential and progressive with activities that are play-oriented and directed. Theme based materials such as- dinosaurs, outer space, classical music composers, jazz musicians, the rain forest, Greek mythology, and Southeast Asia- are used to teach the basic elements of music and movement.

Students play pitched and non-pitched percussion instrument both individually and in groups, and use a variety of engaging props for movement and dance activities. All materials taught are specifically age appropriate and class size is limited, with a teacher to student ratio of no more than 1 - 8. Through the course of the year, different instrumentalists are brought in to demonstrate their respective instruments in an intimate setting for the children.

Classes for 2.6 to 6years old are team-taught by two professionals: a music specialist trained in Orff and Kodály pedagogy methods, and a movement and dance specialist. Classes for children from eighteen months to three years of age require a parent or caregiver to be present and participating in class.
