

ORIENTATION FOR NEW STUDENTS

September 2nd and 3rd, 2009

Students must be present for both days for Placement exams, student's advisement and registration.

Your tuition for the first semester \$4,200 plus Student Services fee \$250.

TOTAL: \$4,450.00 USD.

Checks should be made payable to Brooklyn-Queens Conservatory of Music.

If you are receiving a partial tuition waiver you should bring the letter from Mr. Kamil (Professional Studies Division Director) showing the amount to be waived and the remaining tuition amount. [Remember: Most of the Conservatory's limited financial aid is reserved for students who have shown their commitment and seriousness, as well as financial need, over the course of 1 or more semesters.]

If you are a foreign F1 Visa student you will also need to bring a valid Passport, Visa with I94 (white card) stapled inside it, and a completed Transfer Form (if you are transferring from another F1 school within the United States).

Failure to provide any of these materials will delay your registration at the Conservatory and within the government SEVIS tracking system.

Placement Tests

All applicants are required to take placement tests (at orientation) in the following subjects:

- THEORY/EAR TRAINING
- MUSIC HISTORY
- ENGLISH (International Students Only)
