SUZUKI PROGRAM (for Fall 2012 entrance)

The Suzuki Method is recognized worldwide as a highly effective approach to teaching children the language of music. The curriculum incorporates three elements that provide the essentials needed for instrumental music education: private lessons, theory classes, and group classes. Parent involvement is an integral component of the Suzuki approach; parents learn and practice alongside the child, functioning as role models and providing encouragement. Generations of students have begun a lifelong journey of musical enrichment through the Suzuki approach. To ensure full understanding of the responsibilities and commitments of our program, parents are required to attend a **Prospective Parent Orientation**.
